Listening

- Understanding conversations in social and academic contexts
- Identifying main ideas, supporting details, and opinions
- Following lectures, discussions, and everyday conversations

Reading (Academic & General Training)

- Reading comprehension of passages from books, newspapers, journals
- Identifying gist, main ideas, and supporting arguments
- Recognizing writer's purpose, tone, and attitude

Writing (Academic)

- Task 1: Describing visual information (graphs, charts, tables, diagrams)
- Task 2: Writing an essay in response to an argument or problem

Writing (General Training)

- Task 1: Writing a letter (formal, semi-formal, or informal)
- Task 2: Writing an essay expressing opinions or providing solutions

Speaking

- Part 1: Answering questions about yourself and familiar topics
- Part 2: Speaking at length on a given topic (cue card)
- Part 3: Discussing abstract ideas and issues in depth
