

TOEFL iBT – Test Content Breakdown

Test Sections

1. Reading (≈ 25%)

- 2 passages (academic texts)
- Each passage followed by 10 questions
- Skills tested:
 - Understanding main ideas
 - Vocabulary in context
 - Inference and detail recognition

2. Listening (≈ 25%)

- Lectures + conversations
- 28–39 questions
- Includes:
 - Classroom discussions
 - Campus conversations

Skills tested:

- Listening for main ideas
- Speaker attitude
- Note-taking

3. Speaking (≈ 25%)

4 tasks:

- 1 independent
- 3 integrated (reading + listening + speaking)
- Duration: ~16 minutes

Skills tested:

- Fluency
- Pronunciation
- Coherence

4. Writing (≈ 25%)

2 tasks:

- Integrated writing
- Academic discussion
- Duration: ~29 minutes

- Skills tested:
- Argument development
- Grammar & structure
- Idea organization
